

**Open Work Session
Water and Sewer Plan Amendment – Town of Sharptown
October 3, 2017**

Mr. Dallas Baker, Director of Public Works, came before Council. Mr. Baker said Sharptown’s engineer was supposed to be present tonight. He said they want to apply for a Water and Sewer Amendment as they want to do some expansion and maintenance of their existing system. He said they have some old pipes they want to replace, and, basically, to get all of that done, they need to change their Water and Sewer Plan to address it so they can get potential funding from MDE to help fund these improvements. Mr. Matt Holloway asked if the County has any issues with this, to which Mr. Baker responded, no. He said this is all relatively straightforward, and they are not proposing anything controversial. He said they are proposing some solar power, some new pumps, and some generators. He said they are including, he believes, a little bit of additional area in their service areas, as they do mention they want to provide new means for future expansion. He said, as far as he is aware, there is not a specific project they have in mind, but it is just more of a general upgrade and maintenance of their system. Mr. Kilmer asked if this is what Sharptown submitted, and the County has made no changes, to which Mr. Baker responded, correct. Mrs. Hurley said this is actually going to require a public hearing, which can be held on November 7, because it has to be advertised two times for two weeks. There was no further discussion.
