A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL & PREVENTION – JUSTICE INFO. SHARING SOLUTIONS (JISS) PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000).

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention solicited grant applications under the Justice Info. Sharing Solutions (JISS) project; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Corrections desires to participate in an initiative to share offender information via the Maryland Criminal Justice Dashboard to all agencies that have dashboard access; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Corrections submitted and grant application and has been award grant funds from the Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention – JISS project in the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000); and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends the acceptance and appropriation of the grant funds from the Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention – JISS Project to be used for the Maryland Criminal Justice Dashboard; and


WHEREAS, the grant funds are to be appropriated to Fund 03 for the Department of Corrections and assigned a project number once this Resolution is accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland, that the County Executive is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate grant funds in the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), from the Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention – Justice Info. Sharing Solutions project.


