Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FROM CONTINGENCY TO THE WICOMICO COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT, IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$77,437), FOR ELECTRICAL AND HVAC UPGRADES.

WHEREAS, Section 709 of the Wicomico County Charter authorizes and empowers the Wicomico County Council, upon the request of the County Executive, to make supplementary appropriations from unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies; and

WHEREAS, with the implementation of Maryland Electronic Courts, the Wicomico County Circuit Court is no longer generating paper files; and

WHEREAS, business offices in Circuit Court that were being used for storage can now be converted back to office space to accommodate increased staffing needs for traditional court programs as well as the Administrative Office of the Courts programs; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Circuit Court has requested funding in the amount of Seventy-Seven Thousand, Four Hundred Thirty-Seven Dollars (\$77,437) for electrical and HVAC upgrades to said office space; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be transferred is not encumbered and funds are available for transfer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the following supplementary appropriation of funds is authorized and approved:
