A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE MOSAIC GROUP, IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$35,000), TO ENHANCE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MARYLAND SCREENING, BRIEF INTERVENTION AND REFERRAL TO TREATMENT (SBIRT) PROGRAM IN THE WICOMICO COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Maryland Screening, Brief Intervention, Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) program is a statewide health care improvement initiative to encourage health care providers and patients to discuss alcohol and drug use as part of routine medical visits; and

WHEREAS, the SBIRT program is now being implemented in the criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Corrections has been awarded grant funding in the amount of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000) from the Mosaic Group to enhance the implementation of the program; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends the acceptance and appropriation of the grant funds from the Mosaic Group to be used to enhance the implementation of the SBIRT Program; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds are to be appropriated to Fund 03 for the Department of Corrections and assigned a project number once this Resolution is accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland, that the County Executive is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate grant funds in the amount of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000), from the Mosaic Group to enhance the implementation of the SBIRT Program in the Department of Corrections.


