A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS, IN THE AMOUNT OF SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FORTY-ONE DOLLARS AND TWENTY-SIX CENTS (\$6,641.26), FROM THE MARYLAND INSTITUTE OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Department of Emergency Services has received grant funding from the Maryland Institute of Emergency Medical Services in the amount of Six Thousand Six Hundred Forty-One Dollars and Twenty-Six Cents (\$6,641.26); and

WHEREAS, the Department of Emergency Services will use the grant funds to support response and training for mass casualty/active assailant incidents; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends accepting the grant funds in the amount of Six Thousand Six Hundred Forty-One Dollars and Twenty-Six Cents (\$6,641.26).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland as follows:

- 1. The County Executive is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate grant funds, in the amount of Six Thousand Six Hundred Forty-One Dollars and Twenty-Six Cents (\$6,641.26) from the Maryland Institute of Emergency Medical Services.
2. The grant funds shall be used to support response and training for mass casualty/active assailant incidents.
3. The County Executive is to establish a grant project number under State Grant Fund 02, upon acceptance of the grant award.
