Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE FROM UNANTICIPATED REVENUE IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, THRITY-FOUR DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-ONE CENTS (\$67,034.71).

WHEREAS, Section 709 of the Wicomico County Charter authorizes and empowers the Wicomico County Council, upon the request of the County Executive, to make appropriations from revenue receipts in excess of those budgeted; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office for Wicomico County has received unanticipated revenue from the State of Maryland for Sex Offender Registration Reimbursement- \$31,600; Pete Richardson's Auction Sales for the sale of Sheriff's vehicles- \$9,183.75 and from the Local Government Insurance Trust (LGIT) for the total loss of a 2015 Dodge Charger - \$26,250.96; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office desires that said revenue be allocated among the accounts specified below to cover vehicle maintenance expenses and to purchase a vehicle to replace the 2015 Dodge Charger that was a total loss; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the funds are available for appropriation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Wicomico County Council that the following appropriations of funds are authorized and approved:
