**Resolution No. 111-2018 (SM)**

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE DATE FOR VOTING ON LEGISLATIVE BILL 2018-09 TO ENACT A NEW CHAPTER 133 OF THE COUNTY CODE TITLED "ANIMAL CONTROL".

WHEREAS, Legislative Bill 2018-09 proposes to repeal the current Chapter of the Wicomico County Code, entitled "Dogs and Other Animals" and enact a new Chapter 133 titled "Animal Control"; and

WHEREAS, Section 311 of the Charter of Wicomico County, Maryland provides that all legislation not passed within sixty (60) days after its introduction shall fail, unless five (5) members of Council affirmatively vote to extend this deadline; and

WHEREAS, Legislative Bill 2018-09 was introduced on August 7, 2018 and will fail if not acted upon by October 6, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the County Council has determined that additional time is needed to review the provisions for the adoption of a new Chapter 133 in the Wicomico County Code titled "Animal Control"; and


WHEREAS, the County Council desires to extend the drop dead date to vote on Legislative Bill 2018-09 to October 16, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the date for voting on Legislative Bill 2018-09, pertaining to the repeal of the current Chapter of the Wicomico County Code, entitled "Dogs and Other Animals" and to enact a new Chapter 133 titled "Animal Control" is hereby extended to October 16, 2018.
