A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS, IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$50,245.00), FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL & PREVENTION.

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention provides local governments with access to federal and state grant funds to improve public safety in Maryland; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention solicited grant applications under the Pretrial Services Program; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Corrections submitted an application and has received grant funding from the Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention, in the amount of Fifty Thousand, Two Hundred Forty-Five Dollars (\$50,245.00); and

WHEREAS, the grant funding will be used to enhance Wicomico County's Pretrial Services Program by expanding the electronic monitoring system to include the "stay away" feature, defray some costs for multi-panel substance tests and to hire an additional person to provide Intensive Pretrial Supervision; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends the acceptance of grant funds from the Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of the Wicomico County, Maryland as follows:

1. The County Executive is hereby authorized to accept grant funds, in the amount of Fifty Thousand, Two Hundred Forty-Five Dollars (\$50,245.00) from the Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention to enhance Wicomico County's Pretrial Services Program.
2. Upon receipt of the grant award from the Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention, a new project number is to be established in Fund 02.
3. The Governor's Office of Crime Control & Prevention grant award shall be applied to the new grant project number established within Fund 02 once accepted.


