A RESOLUTION TO INCREASE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE WICOMICO COUNTY NATURAL RESOURCES CONSERVATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE FROM NINE TO TEN MEMBERS BY ADDING A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE CITY OF SALISBURY.

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Natural Resources Conservation Advisory Committee was established on May 19, 2009, as evidenced by Resolution No. 74-2009; and

WHEREAS, the membership of the Wicomico County Natural Resources Conservation Advisory Committee consists of a forester, wildlife expert, wetland expert, local land trust representative, member of a local environmental organization, representatives from the agricultural community, Recreation Commission, Planning and Zoning Commission and a member of the County Council; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Wicomico County Natural Resources Conservation Advisory Committee have requested to increase the membership of the committee from nine to ten members by adding a representative from the City of Salisbury; and


WHEREAS, the County Executive has determined that it is in the best interest of the County to increase the membership of the Wicomico County Natural Resources Conservation Advisory Committee from nine to ten members to include a representative from the City of Salisbury.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the membership of the Wicomico County Natural Resources Conservation Advisory Committee shall increase from nine to ten members to include a representative from the City of Salisbury.


