A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING JAILCRAFT, INC. AS A SOLE SOURCE VENDOR FOR THE REPLACEMENT AND/OR REPAIR OF DOORS AT THE WICOMICO COUNTY DETENTION CENTER AND TO WAIVE THE FORMAL COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS FOR THE REPLACEMENT/REPAIR OF SAID DOORS DURING FISCAL YEAR 2019.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 802 (A), any single purchase or contract involving an expenditure of more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) or such amount as may be set by legislative act of the county shall be made from or let by sealed bids or proposals; and

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2017, the County Council approved Legislative Bill 2017-04 enacting a new Purchasing Manual and setting the amount for competitive bidding to Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 802 (B), the County Council may waive the formal competitive bidding process for any single purchase or contract if the waiver will best serve the interest of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Corrections desires to purchase to replace and repairs doors at the Wicomico County Detention Center; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive, upon the recommendation from the Purchasing Agent, has determined that it is impractical to competitively bid the door replacement and repair as Jailcraft, Inc. is the only vendor on the Eastern Shore available to perform the maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the County Council has determined that the door replacement and repairs at the Wicomico County Detention Center is in the best interest of the County.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland as follows:

1. Jailcraft, Inc. is authorized as a sole source vendor for the door replacement and repairs at the Wicomico County Detention Center during Fiscal Year 2019.
2. The formal competitive bidding requirement is hereby waived for the Detention Center door replacement and repairs during Fiscal Year 2019.
3. To ensure a transparent environment that is open and fair, the approval of Jailcraft, Inc. as a sole source vendor and the waiver for competitive bidding shall be valid only during Fiscal Year 2019.




