Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF BRETT CALLOWAY TO THE WICOMICO COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTRICAL EXAMINERS.

WHEREAS, Section 413 of the Wicomico County Charter provides for the County Executive to appoint and for the County Council to confirm nominees to Wicomico County Boards and Commissions created by law; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 138, Section 4B of the Wicomico County Code provides for a Board of Electrical Examiners. The panel shall consist of one representative from the general public, one representative from a local electrical utility company, one shall be an electrical inspector, two shall be engaged in the electrical contracting business for a period in excess of five years and one may represent a local electric utility company or may be an electrical inspector or be engaged in the electrical contracting business; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has proposed the reappointment of Brett Calloway, as a representative from the general public, to the Board of Electrical Examiners; and


WHEREAS, the County Council ratifies the County Executive's special trust and confidence in the abilities of the nominee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that Brett Calloway is confirmed as a member of the Wicomico County Board of Electrical Examiners to serve from the passage of resolution to January 15, 2022 or until a successor is appointed and confirmed.
