A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE LOWER EASTERN SHORE HERITAGE COUNCIL, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED THIRTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$2,934), FOR THE PIRATE'S WHARF MASTER PLAN AND PARK DEVELOPMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Department of Recreation, Parks & Tourism submitted a grant application and received a grant award, in the amount of Two Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Four Dollars (\$2,934) from the Lower Eastern Shore Heritage Council; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used for the Pirate's Wharf Master Plan and Park Development Project to include hiring a consultant to develop content for interpretive signage and/or exhibits to tell the story of the Pirate's Wharf property; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends the acceptance of the grant award, in the amount of Two Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Four Dollars (\$2,934) from the Lower Eastern Shore Heritage Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland as follows:

- 1. The County Executive is hereby authorized to accept a grant award from the Lower Eastern Shore Heritage Council, in the amount of Two Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Four Dollars (2,934).
2. A new project number for the Lower Eastern Shore Heritage Council Grant Funds is to be established within fund 02.
3. The grant award from the Lower Eastern Shore Heritage Council shall be applied to the new grant project number established within fund 02.
