A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE RE-APPOINTMENT OF SHEREE SAMPLE-HUGHES TO THE WICOMICO COUNTY SOCIAL SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD.

WHEREAS, Section 413 of the Wicomico County Charter provides for the County Executive to appoint and for the County Council to confirm nominees to Wicomico County Boards and Commissions created by law; and

WHEREAS, the Annotated Code of Maryland, Title 3, entitled "Local Departments of Social Services," Section 3-501, provides for a Social Services Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the local governing authority shall designate one member of the local governing authority to serve as an ex officio member of the local board; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has proposed the re-appointment of Councilwomen Sheree Sample-Hughes as an ex officio member of the Wicomico County Social Services Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, local governing officials shall be members of the Social Services Advisory Board only during their term in office as an elected official; and

WHEREAS, the County Council ratifies the County Executive's special trust and confidence in the abilities of the nominee.




