A RESOLUTION REQUESTING A 'STRAW BALLOT' ON THE ISSUE OF AN ELECTED SCHOOL BOARD IN WICOMICO COUNTY.

WHEREAS, The Annotated Code of Maryland, Education Article, Title 3, entitled "Establishment of County Boards of Education" provides for an appointed or elected school board in each county; and

WHEREAS, the local Board of Education plays an important and essential role in the efficient operation of the local school system, and decisions made by the local board of education directly influence the academic success of students in the Wicomico County Public School system; and

WHEREAS, the members of the current school board are appointed by the governor; and

WHEREAS, ~~a proposal has been submitted to~~ THE COUNTY COUNCIL HAS RECEIVED NUMEROUS REQUESTS THAT WICOMICO COUNTY switch to an elected school board; and


WHEREAS, the Council desires to have the issue presented to the citizens of Wicomico County and therefore desires to forward the proposal to the Maryland General Assembly for consideration of a "straw ballot".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland hereby requests and supports legislation by the Maryland General Assembly to place a question on the ballot at the next general election IN 2012 for a "straw vote" on the establishment of an elected school board for Wicomico County consisting of 7 members elected in a nonpartisan election; 1 member from each of the councilmanic districts and 2 from the county at large.
