A RESOLUTION MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FROM CONTINGENCY TO THE STATE'S ATTORNEY OFFICE IN THE AMOUNT OF ELEVEN THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND FORTY-FOUR CENTS (\$11,638.44).

WHEREAS, Section 709 of the Wicomico County Charter authorizes and empowers the Wicomico County Council, upon the request of the County Executive, to make supplementary appropriations from the unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget; and

WHEREAS, the pre-trial phase for the State vs. Thomas Leggs case has created a negative balance in the State's Attorney's Special Prosecutions account; and

WHEREAS, the State's Attorney has requested funding to offset the negative balance in the Special Prosecutions account; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be transferred is not encumbered and funds are available for transfer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland, that the following supplementary appropriation of funds is authorized and approved:

Transfer From Account: General Fund Contingency - 01080046-520261 - (\$11,638.44)

Transfer To Account: State's Attorney Special Prosecutions - 01010004-530034 - \$11,638.44
