A RESOLUTION INCREASING THE RABIES CLINIC VACCINATION FEE.

WHEREAS, the Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR), Codification Number 10.06.02.10, requires that the local Health Department offer at least two rabies clinics annually with at least one conducted between April 1 and July 1; and

WHEREAS, historically the Human Society for Wicomico County has conducted the Rabies Clinics; however, due to finances, they will no longer be able to perform this service; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Health Department will now be rendering this service and has requested that the vaccination fee, per animal, be \$10.00 to cover the costs of operating the Rabies Clinics; and

WHEREAS, the County Council of Wicomico County has determined that it is desirable to increase the Rabies Clinic vaccination fee hereinafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the Rabies Clinic vaccination fee set forth below is hereby adopted.

Chapter 141

FEES

§ 141-2. Dogs.

A. Imposition of fee. Pursuant to the authority of §133-3B of Chapter 133, the fee for vaccination at the Rabies Clinic shall be ~~\$3~~ \$10.00 for each animal vaccinated.


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
