

**Open Work Session
County Council Goals for Fiscal Year 2022
July 6, 2021**

Mr. McCain said they talked at their last meeting about how they have several things on their plate right now, so Mrs. Hurley gave them charts to fill out with their goals. He said, for the sake of time, maybe they can bring the charts back to the next meeting, or maybe they can discuss a few things right now.

Mr. Dodd said one of the biggest goals for him is water and sewer. Mr. McCain agreed and said maybe they need to set specific timeframes on that because they are so far behind on that issue. He said there are some other variables that come with it, such as making sure they are protecting their ag district, and then there is the whole zoning side of it as they expand sewer, but once again they do not have anybody here this evening to discuss this.

Mr. Dodd asked Mrs. Hurley, when did Mr. Psota say they would be done with that consultant report, to which Mrs. Hurley responded, she thinks he is expecting it any day. She said it was May or June, but then he wanted some additional time to review it before he presents it to the Council, but he should be expecting it any day. Mr. Dodd asked if the Council is going to get a copy of that when it is presented so they can digest it just like Mr. Psota, to which Mr. Cannon responded, since they approve the funding for it, he would say yes. Mr. Davis said the Council should get a copy of it. Mr. Dodd said it did not sound like the Council was going to get the copy at first, to which Mrs. Hurley responded, her understanding was that Mr. Psota wanted time to review it before it was presented to Council, so they would have to check with Mr. Psota. Mr. Davis said the Council approved the funding for it. Mr. Holloway asked Mrs. Hurley to call Mr. Psota tomorrow and tell him they want to see it.

Mr. Cannon said, regarding goals, he has about 17, which he would be glad to share with the entire Council, but he can just send an email on it. He clarified, this is very important, but it is getting very late, so they could certainly do this in another Work Session. He said a few of his goals are wastewater, branding of Wicomico County as a whole, etc., but he will send them out.


Mr. McCain suggested they all fill out their charts and then they can all share their goals, and maybe put this on the Agenda for the next meeting.


