A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE WICOMICO COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS OR AGREEMENTS FOR DELIVERY OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES WITH THIRD PARTIES.

WHEREAS, Governor Martin O'Malley, on May 10, 2011, approved House Bill 709, which authorizes a health officer, subject to the consent of the governing body of the County and written approval of the State Secretary of Health, to enter into a contract or any other written agreement to assist or participate in the delivery of health care services with a person that is authorized to provide, finance, coordinate, facilitate, or otherwise deliver health care services in the State; and


WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Health Officer has submitted a request to the County Board of Health to obtain authorization to enter into contracts and agreements for the delivery of health care services; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Health consists of the County Council and the County Executive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF WICOMICO COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Wicomico County Health Officer is authorized to enter into contracts or agreements for delivery of health care services, in accordance with House Bill 709, adopted on May 10, 2011 and effective October 1, 2011.






