A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2011 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM SUB-RECIPIENT AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF WICOMICO COUNTY, MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, the State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSP) is annually awarded by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security to State Administrative Agencies for allocation to local jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, program funds are to be used to build capabilities at the state and local levels and to implement the goals and objectives included in state homeland security strategies and initiatives in their State Preparedness Report; and

WHEREAS, Wicomico County Emergency Management Agency has made application and has been awarded funding in the amount of \$126,394.38 for the SHSP grant performance period commencing on September 1, 2011 and ending May 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, a provision in the standard assurances, included as part of the grant application package, indicates that a resolution, motion or similar action by the applicant's governing body shall be adopted or passed authorizing the filing of the application and designating an official representative to act in connection with the application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland, that the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute the 2011 Sub-Recipient Agreement for Wicomico County Emergency Management Agency.
