A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE ON BEHALF OF WICOMICO COUNTY A LEASE TO THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 22-1 of Chapter 22, entitled "County-owned property" paragraph E the County Executive is authorized and empowered to lease county property in furtherance of public purposes; and

WHEREAS, approval of the County Council is required for any lease of county property for a lease term of more than one year; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration would like to extend their lease on space within the Old Airport Terminal Building; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive proposes that Wicomico County, Maryland enter into a lease agreement with the Federal Aviation Administration for an additional term of 5 years and be given the authority to execute such agreement on behalf of Wicomico County, Maryland; and


WHEREAS, The Federal Aviation Administration shall pay rent at an annual rental rate of \$10,920.00. The lease shall be a full service lease and shall include all service and utilities; and


WHEREAS, the leased premises shall be used by the Federal Aviation Administration for office space.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the County Executive be, and is hereby, authorized to execute, on behalf of the County, a lease agreement with the Federal Aviation Administration for an additional term of 5 years at an annual rental rate of \$10,920.00.


