A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE ENGAGEMENT OF THE FIRM OF PIGG, KRAHL, STERN & COMPANY (PKS) TO PERFORM THE INDEPENDENT AUDIT OF THE COUNTY'S FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS REQUIRED BY SECTION 904 OF THE CHARTER OF WICOMICO COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the existing contract with PKS expired upon the completion of the FY2007 audit, and

WHEREAS, the County is in the process of completing a transition from the ACI financial system to the MUNIS System which requires the auditors to have an intimate understanding of both systems, and

WHEREAS, new accounting standards take effect in FY 2008, which will require substantial internal control work; and

WHEREAS, PKS, by virtue of their prior experience with the County audit, have the necessary familiarity with both the ACI and Munis financial systems as well as the internal controls of the County; and

WHEREAS, for the reasons stated, the Director of Finance with the concurrence of the County Executive recommends the engagement of PKS for an additional period of 3 years as the independent auditors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the firm of Pigg, Krahl, Stern & Company (PKS) be engaged to perform the independent audit of the County's financial transactions required by Section 904 of the Charter for a period of 3 years.




