A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF DR. CAROL LEWIS TO THE APPEALS BOARD FOR VICIOUS DOGS AND THE DESIGNATION OF DR. JACLYN WOLINSKI AS AN ALTERNATE, BOTH WITH HEALING HANDS ANIMAL HOSPITAL.

WHEREAS, Section 413 of the Wicomico County Charter provides for the County Executive to appoint and for the County Council to confirm nominees to Wicomico County Boards and Commissions created by law; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 133, Subsection D(2) of the Wicomico County Code provides for an Appeals Board for Vicious Dogs. The panel shall consist of a representative from the Sheriff's Office, a representative from the Health Department and a licensed veterinarian.

WHEREAS, the County Executive has proposed the appointment of Dr. Carol Lewis as a member of the Appeals Board for Vicious Dogs and the designation of Dr. Jaclyn Wolinski as an alternate, both with Healing Hands Animal Hospital; and


WHEREAS, the County Council ratifies the County Executive's special trust and confidence in the abilities of the nominees.


