A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CLOSURE OF A FUTURE STREET EXTENSION LOCATED IN TRIINTY MANOR, SECTION 1, OFF CALVARY CIRCLE BETWEEN LOT 14, BLOCK B, AND LOT 12, BLOCK D.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 15 of Chapter 197, entitled "Altering, relocating or closing streets and roads" paragraph A, a County road may not be closed unless the County Council has approved the closing, alteration or relocation of the road by resolution or by the approval of a capital project; and

WHEREAS, James E. Palmer, Jr. and Kimberly L. Palmer have filed a petition with the Director of the Department of Public Works requesting the closing of a future street extension located in Trinity Manor, Section 1, off Calvery Circle between Lot 14, Block B, and Lot 12, Block D; and

WHEREAS, James E. Palmer, Jr. and Kimberly L. Palmer will pay all costs associated with advertising the proposed closing, notifying persons whose property adjoins the road and legal expenses; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the future extension road closure will not adversely affect public safety, the traffic network, or public convenience; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, Department of Planning and Zoning, Emergency Services, and Sheriff's Department have recommended the approval of the future street extension road closure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the future street extension located in Trinity Manor, Section 1, off Calvery Circle between Lot 14, Block B, and Lot 12, Block D, is hereby closed and the County Executive is authorized to execute a Quit Claim Deed accordingly.
