A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE ON BEHALF OF WICOMICO COUNTY A LEASE TO S & H FARMS, INC.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 22-1 of Chapter 22, entitled "County-owned property" paragraph E the County Executive is authorized and empowered to lease County property in furtherance of public purposes; and

WHEREAS, approval of the County Council is required for any lease of County property for a lease term of more than one year; and

WHEREAS, S & H Farms, Inc. submitted a proposal to lease 72 acres of tillable land, owned by Wicomico County, located southeast of Whitehaven Road as indicated on County Tax Map 55, Grid 6, being part of Parcel 128, located in the Quantico Election District; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive proposes that Wicomico County, Maryland enter into a lease agreement with S & H Farms, Inc. for an initial term of one year, with two additional one year renewal options, and be given the authority to execute such agreement on behalf of Wicomico County, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, S & H Farms, Inc. shall pay rent at an annual rental rate of \$15,198.48 for the initial term. The rental for each renewal term shall be increased by the cost of living.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the County Executive be, and is hereby, authorized to execute, on behalf of the County, a lease agreement with S & H Farms, Inc. for an initial term of one year at an annual rental rate of \$15,198.48, with two additional one year renewal options.
