Proposal Solicitation – Increasing Trauma Informed Care - REBID

Wicomico Partnership for Families and Children with funding from the Governor's Office has allocated funding for a Trauma-Informed Care Program. The Trauma-Informed Care program will focus on 1) increasing the number of mental health practitioners in Wicomico County who have the full Trauma Focused – Cognitive Behavioral Treatment Certification (TF-CBT) and 2) increasing the number of youth served by TF-CBT trained professionals in order to mitigate negative trauma related outcomes and increase resilience in youth and families to succeed throughout their experiences, in conformity with the requirements contained herein Proposal Documents.
