



Rules of Conduct for Early Voting Processing Observers – Wicomico County

Members of the public and media are encouraged to observe the local board of canvassers process the Early Voting results. During the processing, it is the responsibility of the local board of canvassers and the Election Director to maintain order and safeguard all records and documents. Please be mindful of the following rules of conduct for individuals observing the processing:

- ❖ All participants, staff and observers must complete a Confidentiality Agreement.
- ❖ Direct all questions to the Election Director
- ❖ You may observe the canvass teams processing the results but must remain in the designated observer area unless otherwise directed.
- ❖ Do **not** touch the voting units, peripherals or other election documents
- ❖ Do **not** make excessive noises or cause distractions
- ❖ No food or drink are allowed in the processing area
- ❖ Do **not** use cell phones or other prohibited devices in the processing room
- ❖ If you have information that you believe should be considered by the Board of Canvassers, immediately notify the Election Director

Processing of Early Voting results will take place at the Board of Elections office, 123 Bateman Street, Salisbury MD at 9 a.m.

Observers will be taken to the designated observation area at that time. Once the observers have been escorted to the processing area by the Election Director, no others will be admitted into the processing area until the processing is completed. Please ensure that you are there prior to 9 a.m.
