Bid: Electronics Recycling – May 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016  
6948 Brick Kiln Road, Salisbury, MD 21801

1. Q: Does any surplus equipment currently exist now?  
A: We have one 53' trailer loaded with TVs and Monitors and around 20 pallets of TVs and Monitors waiting to be shipped, we also have four to six pallets of miscellaneous electronics.
2. Q: Do you have any estimations on the amount of surplus that will be disposed of over the entire course of this contract?  
A: Three to five trailer loads of electronics are estimated to be shipped for the bid duration.
3. Q: Are there any expected upcoming models & or quantities for the future equipment?  
A: We have no known upcoming models expected. There are televisions and monitors dropped off on a daily basis.
4. Q: Will the equipment primarily be coming from businesses or residences? What is the ratio of business to residence surplus?  
A: We receive from businesses and residential, the ratio is not monitored therefore not available.
5. Are you able to palletize?  
A: We palletize and shrink wrap before loading on trailers.

6. Q: How many locations will need to be picked up from? Is it just the one landfill location or are there additional locations?

A: One location, 6948 Brick Kiln Rd., Salisbury, MD 21801

7. Q: Does the pickup location have a loading dock?

A: Yes, the loading dock can be accessed by a full sized semi-truck.

8. Q: Is there a forklift on site that could be utilized? If so, could we operate it or do you require one of your employees to operate it?

A: Our employees are the only ones that will load trailers.

9. Q: Would you happen to have any details of the last contract such as any bid tabulations or know of the previous volume of surplus that was disposed of?

A: The Bid Tabulations are posted on the County website: [www.wicomicocounty.org](http://www.wicomicocounty.org) and can be viewed there. The answers to questions One and Two (above) are based on the past volumes. The volume seems to remain consistent.

10. Q: What would you like to see done better than the previous vendor?

A: The last company worked well, the contract expired. They have the opportunity to submit a bid for this contract period.

11. Q: What's your main area of need/concern?

A: Our main concern is that the awarded vendor has certifications that the electronics are recycled in a green and eco-friendly manner.
