## Wicomico County Department of Public Works

### Pipe Installation Process if located within County Right-of-Way

The Department of Public Works Roads Division must be contacted prior to installation of new or upgraded entrances on to County Roads to ensure that roadside drainage is not impacted.

Resident applicants must flag the exact location for the pipe. The Department of Public Works will determine the diameter and type of pipe to be used. The owner will then furnish the pipe at their expense.

In addition to the Standard requirements above, the below applies to Nonstandard Pipe Installation:

- a. Requests for additions to existing driveway pipes will be charged a per foot installation cost for size of pipe requested.
- b. Requests for multiple pipe installations being installed at the same time will be charged the single installation price for that length and size of pipe.
- c. Requests for replacing existing pipes will be charges as a new installation.

## **Wicomico County Department of Public Works**

Property owners proposing something other than the Standard driveway entrance design or requesting permission to install longer lengths of pipe must submit a drainage design to be reviewed by the Wicomico County Department of Public Works Engineer. A professional consultant may be necessary to complete the submission. See Sections B-E.

For others (commercial, institutional, industrial, and subdivision) all pipe installation requests should be included in the site plan design for review by the Wicomico County Department of Public Works Engineer for approval.

6. \_\_\_\_\_ Outline of the entire lot or parcel
7. \_\_\_\_\_ Outline of adjacent property owners and approximate lot line locations
8. \_\_\_\_\_ Streets and roads adjacent to the lot or parcel
9. \_\_\_\_\_ Significant topographical, environmental features

#### **C. Pre-development/ Existing Conditions**

Show all existing conditions that may be impacted by the pipe installation.

#### **D. Site Entrance/Storm Drainage Pipe Design:**

Include all drainage and traffic control information.
