AN ACT to amend the Wicomico County Classification and Pay Plan by the addition of a certain job classification in the Department of Information Technology and establishing a certain class title and grade.

PREAMBLE

The Wicomico County Classification and Pay Plan provides a system of standardized title and common job language critical to the effective administration of County personnel.

The Department of Information Technology recommends the establishment of a new position titled "Admin Office Associate I" within the Information Technology to enhance the efficiency of the day-to-day operations of the department.

SECTION I. BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF WICOMICO COUNTY, MARYLAND, IN LEGISLATIVE SESSION, that the Wicomico County Classification and Pay Plan is hereby amended as follows:

The following specified job classification and grade is hereby added:

Department of Information Technology

<u>Classification</u>	<u>Grade</u>
Admin Office Associate I	16

SECTION II. Be it Further Enacted, that this Bill shall not be codified in the Wicomico County Code.

SECTION III. Be It Further Enacted, that this Bill shall be known as Bill No. 2017-09 of Wicomico County, Maryland and shall take effect sixty (60) days after its enactment, unless a proper Petition for Referendum thereof shall be filed prior to said date; in which event, the Bill shall not take effect until the expiration of thirty (30) days following the approval of this Bill by a majority of the qualified voters of the County voting in any such referendum.






