LEGISLATIVE BILL 2017 - 11

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 197, Section 37 of the Wicomico County Code, entitled "Speed-monitoring systems."

WHEREAS, Wicomico County had adopted speed camera legislation as permitted by the *Annotated Code of Maryland, Transportation Article*, in Section 21-809; and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Sheriff has determined that the deterrent effect of speed cameras does not justify the expense of operating a speed camera system; and

WHEREAS, the County Council deems it advisable to repeal Chapter 197, Section 37, entitled "Speed-monitoring systems."

SECTION I: BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF WICOMICO COUNTY, MARYLAND, IN LEGISLATIVE SESSION, that Chapter 197, Section 37 entitled "Speed-monitoring systems," be repealed in its entirety.

CHAPTER 197

~~Section 197-37 Speed-Monitoring Systems.~~

- ~~A. In this article, "speed monitoring system" means a device with one or more motor vehicle sensors producing recorded images of motor vehicles traveling at least 12 miles per hour above the posted speed limit.~~
- ~~B. The use of speed monitoring systems is authorized within the County in accordance with § 21-809 of the Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland. The County may use and enforce citations issued from speed monitoring systems within the County.~~
- ~~C. The civil penalty for violations recorded by a speed monitoring system shall be \$40.~~
- ~~D. The Office of the Sheriff for Wicomico County, in consultation with other offices and departments of the County government, may develop a program for the use and implementation of speed monitoring systems, in accordance with § 21-809 of the Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland.~~

SECTION II: BE IT FURTHER ENACTED THAT this Legislative Bill shall be known as Legislative Bill No. 2017-11 of Wicomico County, Maryland, and shall take effect sixty (60) days after its final passage, unless a proper Petition for Referendum thereof shall be filed prior to said date; in which event, the Bill shall not take effect until the expiration of thirty (30) days following the approval of this Bill by a majority of the qualified voters of the County voting in any such referendum.

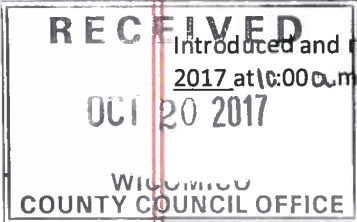
