Department of Emergency Services is monitoring Tropical Event Michael.

**NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE HAS ISSUED NO WEATHER ADVISORIES,
WATCHES, OR WARNINGS FOR WICOMICO COUNTY AT THIS TIME.**

*TIMING: Thursday night, October 11, and Friday, October 12

*PRECIPITATION: 2 to 3 inches

*TEMPERATURES: Mid 60's

*WINDS: Thursday—12 to 17 mph—Gusts to 29 mph
Friday—18 to 22 mph—Gusts to 36 mph

*FORECASTED DISTANCE:

Tropical event is predicted to be approximately 155 miles southeast of Wicomico County at 2 am Friday, Oct 12 as a Tropical Storm

*TIDES/FLOODING: possible for minor flooding at periods of high tides

*PRECAUTIONS: Residents should continue to monitor their local media for any changes in the track or forecast. Due to the winds predicted, it would be prudent to secure any outside loose objects.
