2. AIRPORT MANAGER'S REPORT

1. Master Plan and ALP –

January 10, 2020. FAA ADO comments were received DEC 5 and a response was sent Jan 10, 2020. It is anticipated that this is the final rally and that with our acceptance of the reduction in runway length, the ADO will finally approve and coordinate with the rest of the FAA. That coordination process is 60 days. Once we have the final FAA approval, we can move forward at a much faster rate.

2. Worcester County Councilmen, Mayor, Hotel Ocean City Hotel-Motel-Restaurant Association, Real Hospitality Group, Greater Ocean City Chamber of Commerce, County Parks and Rec, Worcester Econ Development, Ocean Downs Casino, and other- (18)

- a. Propose funding sources for SBY Regional Airport
- b. ADS-B shared if share cost for OC Airport
- c. Lots of interest on putting Airport on Boards in OC. More to come-
- d. Very interested in a BWI Flight- and would support Minimum Revenue Guarantees.

3. Salisbury Mayor- Jake Day toured SBY for about 2 hours. Great Discussions on Airport development.

4. Revised Minimum Standards –Are in the final stage of revision for submission to County Executive. Will include the CFC, new fuel concession requirements for reporting and payment requirements, and a requirement for disabled aircraft to vacate the runway within one hour or airport has the authority to remove and not be responsible for damage.

5. Meet with two potential FBOs. -Productive meetings with two separate companies interested in being a full-service FBO with maintenance.

6. Project and Contract Status Update

a. UAS Hangar construction date – Ground Breaking Ceremony on Jan 27 @0900 in the Airport Passenger Lounge and catered by Rosenfeld.

b. Site Ready Prep for the new FBO site prep is under contract- FAA 7460s are pending. Should have concrete and steel rails and CAP and FEMA trailer are removed.

7. GA Sales Tax on Parts for Maintenance- Calvin and I are working with State leadership for a revision to the fiscal note provided in 2019 for a more positive and realistic look at the economic and state tax impact.

Dawn will testify on Thursday for the House Bill and provide written testimony for the Senate bill.

8. Junior Achievement- Last week in Feb. – much larger than last year- at the OC Convention Center- Need assistance with Hands-On aviation activities. For Middle School age student. Finalizing- we have requested a 65 x 65 space for equipment and demos.
