2. AIRPORT MANAGER'S REPORT

- 1. Master Plan and ALP** – The Master Plan Narrative report is being reviewed and expected to be finalized and sent to FAA this week.
- 2. Project and Contract Status Update**
 - a. UAS Hangar construction date** – Ground Breaking Ceremony Jan 27 @0900 was a huge success- SRS and SBY phones and email exploded.
 - b. Site Ready Prep** for the new FBO area – bids were received and being reviewed. Should have concrete and asphalt removed in next few months.
 - c. Taxiway A** – Pre-construction meeting scheduled for February 20th. Project should start shortly after as weather permits.
 - d. Air Carrier Apron** - Pre-construction meeting to be scheduled soon and construction should begin in March or April.
- 3. GA Sales Tax on Parts for Maintenance-** Calvin can provide and update - SENATE passed as it has for the past 5 years. House- TBD
- 4. Junior Achievement-** Last week in Feb. – much larger than last year- at the OC Convention Center- Need assistance with Hands-On aviation activities. For Middle School age student. Finalizing- we have requested a 65 x 65 space for equipment and demos. Kilroy, SBY, SRS, TSA cannot attend, ARFF, etc. AOPA cannot attend.
- 5. FAA issued a NPRM and Notice of Policy** for UAS Aircraft Certification criteria. Looks very good-
- 6. Meeting with ATO** – ADS-B will not resolve our issues on ONE-IN and ONE-OUT. Since the military and some GA aircraft are currently not required to be equipped with ADS-B, they may not be seen. We need a radar. It was suggested a mobile radar be deployed and tried to see if it would accomplish what we need to resolve our issue. ATO agreed something

needs to be done to rectify this issue. PAX River is will to work with us. I suggested they schedule an Exercise here that requires a mobile radar, and test it out. PAX and Dover will see what they can put together.

ATO's UAS – They suggested Bill Penna and I visit NY Test site to see and learn from their implementation. Bill and I will see about a quick trip with Harris Corp. and John Hopkins Univ.
