Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FROM CONTINGENCY TO THE COUNTY COUNCIL OFFICE IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED NINE DOLLARS AND TWELVE CENTS (\$2,809.12).

WHEREAS, Section 709 of the Wicomico County Charter authorizes and empowers the Wicomico County Council, upon the request of the County Executive, to make supplementary appropriations from the unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget; and

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland, in 2012, enacted *The Sustainable Growth and Agricultural Preservation Act of 2012*, commonly referred to as the "Septic Bill", which may limit the number of residential septic systems allowed on property within the A-1 Agricultural-Rural Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, the County Council will hold a public hearing on the proposed area for limiting septic systems, on February 20, 2013, at 6:00 p.m., in the Midway Room of the Wicomico Youth & Civic Center; and

WHEREAS, a public notice will be published in the local newspaper and postcards will be mailed out to property owners within the A-1 Agricultural-Rural Zoning District that will provide notice of the upcoming public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the County Council Office has requested funding for the postage and advertising costs; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be transferred is not encumbered and funds are available for transfer.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland, that the following supplementary appropriation of funds is authorized and approved:


