A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE CHESAPEAKE BAY TRUST IN THE AMOUNT OF FORTY-NINE THOUSAND, FORTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$49,043.00).

WHEREAS, the Chesapeake Bay Trust, in partnership with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Chesapeake Bay Program Office and the Maryland Department of Natural Resources, provides grant funding for projects designed to improve water quality in the Maryland Chesapeake Bay watershed and the Maryland Coastal Bays; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works in conjunction with the Department of Planning, Zoning and Community Development submitted a grant application to the Chesapeake Bay Trust-Watershed Assistance Grant Program, and the County has been awarded a grant in the amount of forty-nine thousand, forty-three dollars (\$49,043.00); and

WHEREAS, the EPA funding comes through the Chesapeake Bay Implementation Grant program; and


WHEREAS, the grant funding will be used to pay a significant portion of the engineering services associated with Phase I Watershed Implementation Projects, which consists of seven stormwater management retrofit projects on publicly-owned land; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends the acceptance of the grant award from the Chesapeake Bay Trust.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the County Executive is hereby authorized to accept the grant award from the Chesapeake Bay Trust in the amount of forty-nine thousand, forty-three dollars (\$49,043.00).


