A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ACCEPT GRANT AWARDS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES, EMERGENCY NUMBER SYSTEMS BOARD, IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FORTY-SIX THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY-THREE DOLLARS AND FIFTY-TWO CENTS (\$46,883.52).

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services, Emergency Number Systems Board, coordinates installation and enhancement of County 9-1-1- emergency telephone number services systems; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Emergency Services submitted grant funding requests to the Emergency Number Systems Board and has been awarded grant funding for the following projects: (1) Logging Recorder (2) CritiCall Personnel Selection/Training Software (3) Aurora 2.X Phone System Upgrade (4) Emergency Telecommunicator Training Manuals (5) Emergency Telecommunicator Medical Dispatch Classroom Training (6) Emergency Telecommunicator Emergency Fire Dispatch Classroom Training; and


WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends the acceptance of the grant awards from the Emergency Number Systems Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the County Executive is hereby authorized to accept grant awards from the Emergency Number Systems Board in the total amount of Forty-Six Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars and Fifty-Two cents (46,883.52). These funds will be managed under a single grant project number, to be established, in the State Grant Fund 02 under Emergency Services.


