Resolution No. 13-2014

Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD, IN THE AMOUNT OF NINETY-NINE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$99,000) FROM THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR RESTORATION TO THE WETIPQUIN BOAT RAMP.

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Natural Resources through the Waterway Improvement Program offers grants to local jurisdictions to expand/improve public boating access and to improve/enhance boating safety; and

WHEREAS, the Wetipquin boat ramp is deteriorating and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Recreation, Parks & Tourism submitted a grant application and has been awarded a grant in the amount of Ninety-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$99,000) for the Wetipquin Boat Ramp Restoration Project; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends acceptance of the grant award; and

WHEREAS, a new project number within fund 02 is needed to track the funding for the Wetipquin Boat Ramp Restoration Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland as follows:

1. The County Executive of Wicomico County, Maryland is authorized to accept a grant award, in the amount of Ninety-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$99,000), from the Maryland Department of Natural Resources for restorations to be made to the Wetipquin boat ramp.
2. A new project number for the Wetipquin boat ramp restoration is to be established within fund 02.
3. The Wetipquin boat ramp restoration grant award, in the amount of Ninety-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$99,000), shall be applied to the new grant project number established within fund 02.


