Resolution No. 48-2013

Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION AMENDING TABLE 14 OF THE WICOMICO COUNTY WATER AND SEWER PLAN TO UPGRADE AND RELOCATE THE FITZWATER STREET PUMPING STATION.

WHEREAS, Title 9, Subtitle 5 of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland requires the County to adopt a comprehensive plan dealing with water supply and sewerage systems, establishes the procedures governing the preparation and adoption of said plan, and provides for amendments and revisions thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has received an application from the City of Salisbury for an amendment to Table 14 of the Wicomico County Water and Sewer Plan, titled "Immediate, 5, and 10 Year Priorities for Sewerage Development"; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has provided the notices required by Title 9, Section 9-503 and has submitted the county plan, revision, or amendment to each official planning agency that has jurisdiction in the County, including any comprehensive planning agency with areawide jurisdiction, for review and comment within a 30 day period for consistency with planning programs for the area; and

WHEREAS, the County Council conducted a public hearing on May 7, 2013 and received public comment thereon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland, that Table 14 of the Wicomico County Water and Sewer Plan, as adopted and as amended is to include the upgrades and location of the Fitzwater Street Sewage Lift Station, as shown in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that within five working days of the adoption of this Resolution, it shall be transmitted to the County Executive for his approval by the Council Administrator.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect on the day it is approved by the County Executive.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the effective date of this Resolution, it shall be submitted to the Maryland Department of the Environment.



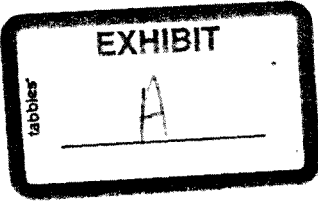
