A RESOLUTION MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FROM CONTINGENCY TO THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE'S OFFICE IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$39,350).

WHEREAS, Section 709 of the Wicomico County Charter authorizes and empowers the Wicomico County Council, upon the request of the County Executive, to make supplementary appropriations from the unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget; and

WHEREAS, County Executive has determine that it is in the best interest of the County to retain the services of a consultant and an attorney to negotiate a Cable Franchise Renewal Agreement with Comcast Cablevision of Delmarva, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, CBG Communications, Inc. and the Cohen Law Group have submitted a Proposal to Provide Cable Television Franchise Renewal Consulting Services for Wicomico County, Maryland and a Scope of Services and Cost Projects, respectively; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has requested funding for the consulting services of CBG Communications, Inc. and the legal services of the Cohen Law Group; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be transferred is not encumbered and funds are available for transfer.


