**Resolution No. 66-2014**

A RESOLUTION TO CERTIFY THE DRAINAGE TAX ROLL TO THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE AS REQUESTED BY THE BOARD OF MANAGERS OF THE PUBLIC DRAINAGE ASSOCIATIONS.

WHEREAS, The Annotated Code of Maryland, Article 25 " County Commissioners" subtitle "Drainage Lands", authorizes the formation of "Public Drainage Associations" as a political subdivision of the State and a public body politic and corporate; and

WHEREAS, Section 59 of the aforesaid article grants the Board of Managers corporate powers; and

WHEREAS, Section 96 of the aforesaid article provides that the Board of Managers shall decide on the tax rate necessary to provide for the payment of drainage improvements maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland, as follows:

The following Drainage Tax Rolls, submitted by the respective Managers of the designated Public Drainage Association are hereby certified to the Director of Finance and shall be included as taxes in the bills for State and County taxes:


