Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY TO ACQUIRE AN EASEMENT, APPROXIMATELY 66 FEET WIDE, ALONG A PORTION OF THE IDLE HEBRON FREIGHT RAILROAD, LOCATED ON THE SOUTHWESTERLY SIDE OF BRICK KILN ROAD, FROM THE MARYLAND TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION.


WHEREAS, the Maryland Transit Administration is the owner of a certain railroad corridor from the City of Salisbury to the Town of Hebron as evidenced by Deed dated January 8, 1982, recorded among the Land Records of Wicomico County in Liber 973, Folio 355; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works desires to obtain an easement, approximately 66 feet wide, along a portion of said railroad corridor, as shown on Exhibit A, from the Maryland Transit Administration for the purchase price of One Thousand, Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200) for access to lands of Wicomico County, Maryland.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the County Executive be, and is hereby, authorized to acquire an easement, approximately 66 feet wide, along a portion of the idle Hebron Freight Railroad, located on the southwesterly side of Brick Kiln Road, as shown on Exhibit A, for the purchase price of One Thousand, Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200).
