Resolution No. 56-2014

Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ALL FUNDS RECEIVED BY WICOMICO COUNTY, MARYLAND FROM THE NARCOTICS TASK FORCE RELATED TO THE FORFEITURES OF MONEY AND SEIZURES OF PROPERTY SHALL BE PLACED DIRECTLY INTO FUND 12 "NARCOTICS TASK FORCE".

WHEREAS, the Wicomico County Narcotics Task Force is the coordinator of a multi-agency law enforcement unit that conducts investigations into the activities of individuals or entities who violate or conspire to violate the controlled dangerous substance laws of the State of Maryland; and

WHEREAS, assets seized in the course of these law enforcement actions are frequently forfeited to the governing body where the property was seized, Wicomico County, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Criminal Procedure Article of the Annotated Code, sections 12-202 and 12-403, and the Wicomico County Narcotics Task Force Agreement, the County shall administer the funds received from the seizure and forfeiture of assets; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends that all such funds related to the forfeitures of money and seizures of property are to be received directly into fund 12 "NARCOTICS TASK FORCE" for the benefit of the Narcotics Task Force.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that all funds received by Wicomico County, Maryland from the Narcotics Task Force related to the forfeitures of money and seizures of property are to be received directly into fund 12 "NARCOTICS TASK FORCE". SUCH DEPOSITS WILL BE CONSIDERED REVENUE AT THE TIME OF RECEIPT AND WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE FOR EXPENDITURE UNTIL APPROPRIATED DURING THE ANNUAL BUDGET CYCLE OR THROUGH THE SUBMISSION OF A MID-CYCLE BUDGET AMENDMENT.


