A RESOLUTION TO DETERMINE THE URBAN SERVICES BILLING FOR THE SEWER USAGE AT 505 LOBLOLLY LANE, SALISBURY, MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works received a letter dated October 30, 2013 from the property owner of 505 Loblolly Lane, Salisbury, Maryland, concerning an unusually high sewer bill; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the unusually high sewer bill is the result of a water leak caused by a toilet that was constantly running; and

WHEREAS, the property owner normally averages 20,000 gallons of usage per quarter, however, the billing for the third quarter in 2013 was for 40,000 gallons; and


WHEREAS, a plumber has made the necessary repairs to fix the leak in the toilet; and

WHEREAS, the property owner has requested for the Urban Services Commission to consider a reimbursement in the amount of Two Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars and Forty Cents (\$222.40), representing one-half of the amount paid of the excessive sewer bill.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the request submitted by Carole Ann Easton Shiles for relief of the sewer bill in the third quarter of 2013 at the location of 505 Loblolly Lane, Salisbury, Maryland, is hereby GRANTED A REIMBURSEMENT AS TO SEWER CHARGES IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO-HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS AND FORTY CENTS (\$222.40).
