A RESOLUTION TO CREATE A COUNTY FUNDED CAPITAL PROJECT TO INSTALL LANDFILL GAS SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS AT THE WICOMICO COUNTY LANDFILL TO COMPLY WITH THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS (COMAR).

WHEREAS, COMAR 26.04.07.03B(9) states "A facility may not be designed or operated in such a manner that the concentration of explosive gases generated by the facility exceeds 25 percent of the lower explosive limits for the gases in facility structures, excluding gas control or recovery system components, and the lower explosive limit for the gases at the property boundary;" and

WHEREAS, to ensure compliance with the regulation, Wicomico County, Maryland Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Division proposes improvements to the existing landfill gas collection system at its Newland Park Landfill Facility; and

WHEREAS, funding of \$551,252 was appropriated for this purpose in the fiscal year 2013 Solid Waste Division operating budget; and

WHEREAS, the work on this project will not be substantially completed before the end of the fiscal year, June 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the annual appropriation will expire before it is reasonably possible to complete the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that a capital project be established within fund 32 by transferring \$551,252 from Solid Waste fund 51 to fund 32 with a specific project number assigned upon this approval.
