A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED AND NINETY-EIGHT DOLLARS (\$22,498), FROM THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, FOR THE COLLECTION AND RECYCLING OF CERTAIN ELECTRONIC DEVICES AT THE NEWLAND PARK LANDFILL.

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Environment ("MDE") provides grants through the Statewide Electronics Recycling Program to counties and municipalities to assist with the collection and recycling of certain electronic equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Division, submitted a grant application and has been awarded a grant in the amount of Twenty-Two Thousand, Four Hundred and Ninety-Eight Dollars (\$22,498) for recycling electronics at the Newland Park Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends acceptance of the grant award from the Maryland Department of Environment; and

WHEREAS, a new project number within State of Maryland Grant Fund 02 is needed to track the funding for the special Electronics Collection and Recycling Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland as follows:

1. The County Executive is authorized to accept a grant award from the Maryland Department of Environment, in the amount of Twenty-Two Thousand, Four Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars (\$22,498), for the collection and recycling of certain electronic devices at the Newland Park Landfill.
2. A new project number for the special Electronics Collection and Recycling Program is to be established within State of Maryland Grant Fund 02.
