Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE ON SERVICE AND VOLUNTEERISM (GOSV) IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED EIGHT DOLLARS (\$1,208).

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office on Service and Volunteerism (GOSV) solicited grant applications from Maryland nonprofit organizations and state agencies that will support one or more service projects that focus on hunger eradication and/or environmental stewardship and is aligned with September 11 Day of Service and Remembrance and/or Maryland's Day to Serve (September 11- September 28); and

WHEREAS, the Wicomico Partnership for Families and Children submitted a grant application and was notified of the GOSV grant award, in the amount of One Thousand, Two Hundred Eight Dollars (\$1,208), with a local in-kind match of fifty percent (50%), after the submission of the annual operating budget; and


WHEREAS, the Wicomico Partnership for Families and Children, in collaboration with Salisbury University, University of Maryland Eastern Shore, and Stop the Violence, will use the grant funds to host "Stop the Violence- Start the Garden," a community garden and food distribution event; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends the acceptance of the grant award from the GOSV.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the County Executive is hereby authorized to accept the grant award from the Governor's Office on Service and Volunteerism in the amount of One Thousand, Two Hundred Eight Dollars (\$1,208).


