Introduced by: The President of the Council at the request of the County Executive

A RESOLUTION MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FROM CONTINGENCY TO GENERAL SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVENTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$17,000).

WHEREAS, Section 709 of the Wicomico County Charter authorizes and empowers the Wicomico County Council, upon the request of the County Executive, to make supplementary appropriations from the unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget; and

WHEREAS, the clock tower at the Old Courthouse has been deemed a hazard due to the deterioration of the trim and fastening system and needs custom milled trim work and clock glazing replacement; and

WHEREAS, General Services has requested funding to cover the costs of the Old Courthouse clock tower renovations; and


WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be transferred is not encumbered and funds are available for transfer.
