A RESOLUTION MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FROM FISCAL YEAR 2014 CONTINGENCY TO GENERAL SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-NINE THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE DOLLARS (\$29,739).

WHEREAS, Section 709 of the Wicomico County Charter authorizes and empowers the Wicomico County Council, upon the request of the County Executive, to make supplementary appropriations from the unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget; and

WHEREAS, General Services has incurred unexpected expenses during Fiscal Year 2014 for the ESG project, New Courthouse HVAC repair work, increased costs for janitorial services, as well as unexpected expenses for Public Safety and the Old Courthouse; and

WHEREAS, General Services has requested funding to cover the costs of the unbudgeted expenses incurred during Fiscal Year 2014; and


WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be transferred is not encumbered and funds are available for transfer.


