A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT SALISBURY DANCE ACADEMY, LLC LOCATED AT 201 W. MAIN STREET, SALISBURY, MARYLAND, IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE ENTERPRISE ZONE BENEFITS.

WHEREAS, the City of Sallsbury, Maryland and Wicomlco County created an Enterprise Zone on June 6, 1983, for the purpose of encouraging economic development of the area encompassed within the boundaries of such zone; and

WHEREAS, the Enterprise Zone was created under authority granted by the State of Maryland; and

WHEREAS, State law permits certain benefits to be extended to businesses that locate or expand In the Enterprise Zone provided that they meet certain standards; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sallsbury and Wicomico County have also established certain standards, which must be met In order for a business to be deemed eligible to receive Enterprise Zone benefits; and


WHEREAS, Sallsbury Dance Academy, LLC located at 201 W. Main Street, Sallsbury, Maryland, meets the standards set forth in the State Code and in local regulations to be eligible to receive Enterprise Zone benefits; and


WHEREAS, Marc and Elena Amy, representing Sallsbury Dance Academy, LLC have requested that the company be designated as eligible for Enterprise Zone benefits because of its investment of more than \$50,000 at their property located in the zone at 201 W. Main Street, Sallsbury, Maryland.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomlco County, Maryland that Sallsbury Dance Academy, LLC be designated as eligible to receive the benefits of the Enterprise Zone effective upon the adoption of this Resolution.
