A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AN APPROPRIATION OF \$144,800 FROM "USE OF PRIOR YEAR FUND BALANCE - CAPITAL" FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, SOLID WASTE DIVISION, TO PURCHASE APPROXIMATELY 23.072 ACRES OF LAND FOR THE FRUITLAND/ALLEN TRANSFER STATION.

WHEREAS, Wicomico County desires to purchase approximately 23.072 acres of land from Banks Holdings, LLC for the Fruitland/Allen Transfer Station; and

WHEREAS, the County Council, on April 16, 2013, approved the purchase of said property as evidenced by Resolution No. 36-2013; and

WHEREAS, the property acquisition was not included in the Fiscal Year 2013 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Acting Director for the Department of Public Works has requested funding from "Use of Prior Year Fund Balance-Capital" to purchase said property; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends using funds from "Use of Prior Fund Balance-Capital" to purchase approximately 23.072 acres of land for the Fruitland/Allen Transfer Station; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified that the funds are available for appropriation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Wicomico County, Maryland that the following appropriation of funds are authorized and approved:
